COMMAND LINE REFERENCE

Command Line	Action
jnbSA	Opens the NetBackup administration interface
jbpsA	Opens the NetBackup user interface
bpps -a	Displays all NBU/MMGR daemons & processes
netbackup stop	Kills all NBU/MMGR daemons & processes
netbackup start	Starts all NBU/MMGR daemons & processes
bpexpdate -m media_id -d 0	Expires all images on specified volume
bpmedia -unfreeze -m media_id [-h media_server]	Changes media state; can be also be used with -unsuspend, -freeze, -suspend
bplabel -m media_id -d density -p volume_pool -o	Writes a NetBackup label on the specified volume
tpclean -L	lists cleaning statistics, can also use the following options: -C drive_name (initiates cleaning) -M drive_name (resets mount time) -F drive_name (set cleaning frequency)
robtest	- must run on media server - be sure to exit when finished - common commands (with examples) m from to m s2 d1 (moves media from slot2 to drive1) s type num s d 1 (displays the status of drive 1) s (displays the status of all slots)
