Objectives	After completing this course, a student will be able to effectively install and manage a Symantec AntiVirus network, and perform advanced antivirus configuration and management techniques to address complex information protection issues.	
Long description	<p>This course prepares system administrators to install and manage a Symantec AntiVirus network, including the integrated Spyware and Adware protection. Using interactive labs, participants learn to install Symantec AntiVirus clients and servers using multiple techniques, including how to set up advanced installation types to meet complex user criteria. The class installs, configures, and tests an entire Central Quarantine environment.</p> <p>Participants learn about and configure different types of virus scans from the central console. They install and configure an internal LiveUpdate server system. They learn about and experiment with the Symantec AntiVirus logs.</p> <p>Participants learn how virus definitions are downloaded and pushed to servers and clients within the Symantec AntiVirus network, which is crucial to network loading and scaling decisions. They learn how configuration options are stored in the network, and how they are pushed to servers and client, advanced discovery techniques and when to use them, how the AutoProtect real time scanning is implemented, and about improvements to scaling features to enhance simultaneous rollouts and updates.</p>	
Short description	Learn how to implement and manage a Symantec AntiVirus network, reduce update sizes, enforce antivirus, Spyware and Adware scanning across the entire enterprise, and protect and manage remote users. For antivirus administrators, this course represents the first step toward mastering the configuration and management of an antivirus network.
